Online mode: Open the jump rope connection app and engage in online exercise. The instant linkage online mode requires the Bluetooth device of the phone to be turned on first.

Offline mode: The device can be used independently (without opening a connected mobile app) Sports data is stored in the memory of the jump rope

The amount of data stored in offline mode is about 40 times. It is recommended to connect to your phone and open the APP program described above after exercising for about 20 times.

Rope Installation Steps Step 1 Pass the rope through the closed round hole (large hole)on the buckle first, then through the hole on the top of the handle.

> Loop the rope back and pass it through the hole on the opposite side of the handle's rotating head.

Adjust The Rope Length Adiust the length of the rope according to the height of the use, rthe specific method is as follows: Stand up straight, step on the middle of the rope, hold the handles with both hands and straighten height for you. Beginners can choose a longer length, about to the height of the chest. As the skipping ability improves, the rope is gradually shortened. After you adjust the length to fit, it is recommended to cut off theexcess rope.


